Religious Education

Dear Year 8, this is an exciting and interesting half- term in RE. By the beginning of September, we will have studied...

The Skills we will learn:

- Demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the Hindu religion and beliefs including:
- Beliefs, practices and sources of authority.
- Influence on individuals.
- Similarities and differences within and/or between religions and beliefs.
- Analyse and evaluate aspects of religion and belief, including their significance and influence.

The Topic(s) we will study: Hinduism : Beliefs, Teachings and Practices

- Hindu beliefs and attitudes toward life after death.
- The study of Hindu Festivals – such as Diwali, Holi, Raksha Bandhan.
- The significance of different Gods/ Goddesses in the Hindu religion.
- The main Hindu rites of passage ceremonies.

The Topic(s) we will study: Why are People Good and Bad?

- Good/Bad – Are human beings made in the image of God?
- “The Fall” as shown in the creation story. What can it tell us about human nature?
- All about Eve? Have women suffered as a result of the story of the fall?
- Alternative views on “The Fall”.

- Text book extracts / bespoke worksheets.
- Active tasks
