



Bideford College Code of Conduct 2020-21

The following behaviour guidelines will be put in place to ensure everyone remains **safe, responsible, successful and happy**.

Student Contract

I will ensure I follow the rules below, which have been put in place to ensure the school remains a calm and productive environment for learning, as well as helping my peers and teachers to minimise Covid-19 transmission:

- I will ensure I arrive at school between 8.30 – 8.40am and enter through the designated entrance for my year group
- I will follow the Bideford College rules and expectations within our behaviour policy
- I am representing Bideford College both in and out of school and I will behave appropriately
- I will not wear an outdoor coat or hat in the college building
- I will wash/sanitize my hands when I arrive at college, after each break and moving into other classrooms at the designated station
- I will tell a member of staff immediately if I feel unwell
- I will remain in the area allocated to my year group bubble throughout the day to ensure that track and trace guidelines can be followed
- I will walk on the left of each corridor and stairwell that have been allocated to my year group bubble
- I will always follow staff instructions, remembering that the adult is in charge
- I will only use my equipment, or the equipment given to me by a member of staff
- I will ensure that I am focused and attentive in all lessons
- I will complete all work set to the best of my ability
- I will only go to the toilets which have been designated to my year group
- I will ensure I stay in the area designated to my year group at break and lunchtimes
- I will always be respectful to other students and adults
- I will leave the school site promptly when dismissed and show respect to others
- In the event of a fire drill I will follow the instructions given by staff
- If I need any further support or I am worried about anything I will talk to my form tutor who will signpost help

I am aware that if I breach the guidelines above, the steps below will be used:

- The class teacher will contact the behaviour support team and inform them of my breach of conduct.
- I will go to my year group behaviour support room, where I will be given support to understand the implications of my behaviour and to make positive changes.
